Amidst an international heritage zone, The Delta Study houses one of the finest centres of learning in the district of Ernakulam. It offers to both boys and girls a tech savvy educational system in a serene ambience without the distraction of a modern city life. Being in Fort Kochi, the students get the benefit of an exposure to an international community. There is an influx of tourists, as Fort Kochi was, once the settlement of Europeans with magnificent churches, imperial buildings and forts.

The school was founded in 1976 by The Delta Schools Society, a public Trust registered under the Travancore Cochin Literary Scientific and Charitable Societies Act of 1955. It started as a Nursery School in a British Bungalow but has now grown into a full-fledged school with classes from play school to XIIth std. on a campus of 4.5 acres with spacious buildings.

The school has been affiliated to the CBSE since 1981. In 1982 the first batch of students appeared for All India Secondary School Examination and by 1986 the school was upgraded to the Senior Secondary level with the +2 batches of Science and Commerce Stream taking their Boards. The school has approximately 1040 students and 80 staff members. It was the munificence and far-sighted vision of our Founder Members that has found fruition in establishing a unique system of education in Fort Kochi.

LOCATION

Located on Tower Road in picturesque Fort Kochi and easily accessible by buses and boats that ply regularly at short intervals, the school is surrounded by scenic beauty and faces the backwaters of the Arabian Sea.


PHILOSOPHY AND OBJECTIVE OF THE SCHOOL

English, Hindi, Malayalam, French, Mathematics, Environmental Science, Integrated Science, Social Science, Computer Science, Moral Science, General Knowledge, Craft, Art, Music, Dance, Physical Education, Yoga + experiential learning, Life skills, Environment Education and Health Education are the subjects taught in classes I to VIII.

INSTRUCTION TIME

The School works for five days in a week, Monday to Friday 1st and 3rd Saturday. The School begins on a working day at 7.35 a.m. with the Morning Assembly. It is followed by zero period from 7.50 a.m.to 8.10 a.m. The academic work comprising 9 periods extends from 8.10 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. There are two breaks from 9.25 a.m. to 9.45 a.m. and 12.05 p.m. to 12.15 p.m. respectively. For Kindergarten, the timing is from 9.00 a.m. to 12.30 p.m.

OPEN HOUSE

Parents are provided the opportunity to get appraised of their wards' academic performance, at the Open House that is organized after every major examination, every term/every academic session.


SCHOOL ACTIVITIES

The School lays great emphasis on extra-curricular activities. They form an integral part of the school curriculum. Participation in House activities, club and literary activities, is compulsory. Important national functions and days are observed. Students have a lot of opportunities to express their creativity and originality. LIBRARY

The school library is well-stocked. It has more than 8000 titles on varied subjects. It is also well equipped with reference books apart from encyclopedias, year books, manuals, directories etc. The library has a vocational guidance section which provides latest information about the various competitive examinations and admissions to institutions of higher learning.

HEALTH AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION

The scheme of physical education is so planned as to ensure the fullest and manifold development of the individuality of the child, enabling him to attain mental soundness, emotional stability, physical maturity and moral values. Games and sports are organized in such a way as to ensure participation by all students at the same time. Students take part in the following games: Football, Cricket, Volley ball, Badminton, Basketball, Tennis and Table Tennis. Besides inter house competitions, school teams participate in the Inter school matches. Professional coaches train the students who form the school teams. A huge football ground and the two-in one synthetic basketball cum tennis court have augmented the sporting facilities offered in school to students. Mini tennis is a unique programme aimed at developing the neuro muscular co-ordination of the students of KG and primary sections. Annual Health checkup is conducted by qualified doctors in tune with CBSE guidelines.

MAGAZINE AND NEWSLETTER

The creativity of students finds an ideal outlet in the Annual Magazine "Harmony". "Delta Pulse" - the newsletter brought out in October and March keep the parents informed of all the activities of the school undertaken during the academic year.


SCHOOL UNIFORM

All students must wear school uniform as per the shades and pattern approved by the school authorities and any irregularity in the uniform without any reason shall be suitably dealt with. The uniform for boys is blue terricot shirts, grey terricot trousers, belt, black socks and black laced shoes. The uniform for girls is blue terricot shirts, grey terricot pinafore, belt, black socks and black laced shoes. In plus two classes the girls' uniform is blue salwar, grey kameez and grey duppattah, black socks and black strapped shoes.

The suggested House Uniform is as follows:

Copernicus : White shorts / trousers / skirts and blue T-Shirt
Ramanuja : White shorts / trousers / skirts and red T-Shirt
Rumi : White shorts / trousers / skirts and green T-Shirt
Schweitzer : White shorts / trousers / skirts and yellow T-Shirt

On Wednesday uniform: polished white canvas shoes with laces and white socks for Boys and Girls (I to XII). The uniform for both boys and girls of KG is grey shorts and blue shirts, black socks and black laced shoes.

The School diary is an essential source of information for all. The calendar provides details of all important dates related to fees, exams, functions and vacation. Students should fill in all details regularly in all other pages. The diary should be brought to school everyday.


REGISTRATION AND ADMISSION

- (1) The lower age limit for admission to kindergarten I is 3 years, kindergarten II is 4 years, and Kindergarten III is 5 years. Similarly for admission to class I the age limit is 6 years. Age is calculated as on 1st June of the year admission is sought.
- (2) The application for registration to KG Section should be sent to the Principal by the 1st of December and for other classes by the 30th of March on a prescribed form attached to the Prospectus. The attested copy of the Birth certificate showing age from the Corporation / Panchayat should be enclosed with the application. A family photograph should be included.
- (3) On receipt of the admission form and registration fees of Rs. 250/- the child's name is registered for admission. Admission test is generally held in the first week of April.
- (4) In classes I to VIII some new admissions are made, but only students from English medium schools affiliated to the CBSE are admitted. The Transfer Certificate should be countersigned by the Regional Officer, CBSE Thiruvananthapuram or the DEO of the concerned educational district.
- (5) New students may be admitted to Class XI of the +2 stage of the Senior School Certificate Examination. Students desirous of getting admission to class XI should get their names registered and then send an attested copy of the mark list of class X within a week of the declaration of the result. No test will be held for those who have studied CBSE syllabus but students will be admitted on merit. Students from other Boards may be admitted based on availability of seats and strictly on merit. It is to be noted that admission to Class XI of students who pass their 10th class examination from The Delta Study will not be automatic. It will strictly be on the basis of merit, their conduct and behaviour in the school till date. The School offers a broad based selection of elective subjects for applicants to plus one to suit their aptitude. A counseling session will be held at school for applicants as well as their parents to help them choose a suitable combination of electives offered. The electives chosen and finalized by the end of July, in the current session, would be registered with the CBSE and the options cannot be changed thereafter, till the student completes his Senior Secondary course. However, a student can opt for additional electives if she/he so desires.

WITHDRAWALS

One month's written notice must be given if a student is to be withdrawn. In case of uncertainty, anticipatory notice may be given which may be cancelled if so desired. For the withdrawal of a student without a month's notice or anticipatory notice, a compensation of three months' tuition fees would have to be paid.

SYSTEM OF PAYMENT

The School has adopted Direct Fee Payment to The Bank a/c from the Academic year 2016-17, in association with The South Indian Bank Ltd. Considering the Feed Back from parents we have decided to introduce the following Fee Payment Modes from the Academic year 2017-18. All parents may avail of the facility offered and make sure that the total fee is paid well before the due date or within the fee payment period.

- 1. **Through Branches of South Indian Bank Ltd**, across India through cash/ SIB Cheque, using the triplicate challan provided by the school. The remittance challan has to be filled up in all respects by the students/Parents with full details as required by the institution. The Student copy of the challan has to be kept safely and produced at the school office, on demand, if necessary.
- 2. Using Virtual Account Number: Virtual Account Code (VAC) integrated for our A/c No- at SIB Fort Cochin Branch is A192A11. The Virtual Account Number (VAN) of student can be made by prefixing the virtual account code to the unique identification number like Roll No. For example, if the student roll no is 845, then the student account number will be. A192A11845 By using this account number and IFSC Code of the Branch, the student / parents can walk into any branch of the bank and make the NEFT to School Account or else it is possible through the Internet Banking NEFT. Hence the school account will be credited with the respective Roll numbers and the school can identify the details of the fee payment.

NB: Any fee payment to School account other than the Virtual Account number will be rejected and the school will not be liable for any loss.
